Supported by the Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County, Trader Joes and now Catholic Charities of Orange County we provide canned vegetables, fruits and other canned staples, dry pastas, rice, and beans, and cereals, bread, fresh produce, eggs, various meat products and milk. Our teams making deliveries have gotten to know the families they serve and have a caring Christian/spiritual connection with them. Each team says a prayer before beginning their delivery journey and again with the family prays the "Lords Prayer". Any new difficulties the clients are experiencing are listened to and conveyed back to the SVDP "Home Visit" Team to act upon.
